NOT INCLUDED:

- Departure tax \$18 (subject to change) and domestic flight tax \$12.10 - for 2 flights (subject to change)
- Immigration tax \$10 (subject to change)
- Items of a personal nature (such as phone calls, souvenirs, laundry, etc.)
- Gratuities for guide, driver and waiters, activity guides

EACH PARTICIPANT **MUST** HAVE A CURRENT PASSPORT that does not expire six (6) months beyond trip date.

An integral part of these trips is the mandatory global giving element for the needy children in Argentina. ALL participants **MUST** take an extra piece of luggage to be checked full of goods for these poor underprivileged children.
