Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need shots?

No, you do not need any shots.

What's the currency?

The currency in Chile is the Chilean pesos. Rate of exchange is about \$1 U.S. = 460-485 Chilean pesos.

Do I need a passport?

Yes. Make sure that on your application your name is spelled exactly as it is on your passport. Also, make sure that your passport is good for 6 months beyond your trip date.

How do I pack?

As you may know, our North American summer is South America's winter. Take clothes appropriate for cool weather. The weather varies from mid 30's in the evening to upper 50's in the day time. Layering is strongly recommended.
