- Ecuador departure tax of U.S. \$40.80 per person (subject to change without previous notice)
- Gratuities for guide, driver and waiters, activity guides

EACH PARTICIPANT **MUST** HAVE A CURRENT PASSPORT that does not expire six (6) months beyond trip date.

An integral part of these trips is the mandatory global fundraising element for a needy organization. ALL participants **MUST** take an extra piece of luggage to be checked full of goods for these poor underprivileged children.
